

Through qualitative research and evaluation, consultancy work and policy analysis we contribute to dismantling unequal power structures and driving sustainable change at organizational and policy levels. We work with an international network of professionals from the areas of global health and wellbeing, gender research and feminist thought, and environment and climate change.



What we do


In order to achieve this our work hast been focused on the following activities:



Knowledge and Media Production

In 2022, our blog Yarrow Global published 9 articles with 1242 unique views and 2,287 views total from **72** different countries.

We published on topics including LGBTQ+ rights and climate change, female genitil mutilation, planetary health, and drought and HIV. We wrote 56% of our posts, and 44% of our posts were authored by external writers.


Here are examples of our work

STRIDEM. Strengthening inclusion of children through empowering mothers

Yerevan and Lake Serevan, 2022. Funded from the **German Foreign Office**

Together with the NGO "Initiative for Educational, Social and Legal inclusion", and with funding by the foreign office of Germany we facilitated a series of workshops on- and offline for multilevel stakeholders in the area of inclusive education in Yereva, **Armenia** and in the surrounding rural areas. Our project worked with local actors to strengthen women-led civil society and **improve** the inclusion of children with disabilities in the **Armenian** education system.

In total, we enhanced the capacities of **36** participants (parents of children with disabilities) on disability-inclusive policies. 25 children with and without disabilities participated in an inclusive dance flashmob which was performed at a light festival in the center of Yerevan in October of 2022. More than 350 NGO representatives, specialists, and parents of children with disabilities participated in program activities and a team of 10, both German and Armenian, contributed to the smooth operation of the project.





Casa do Povo

Podcast "Bom retiro é o mundo" (German: **Großstadtfantasien/Urban fantasies)** Sao Paulo, Brasilien, 2021 – 2022. Funded by Brot für die Welt

In 2022 we collaborated with the Brazilian community center Casa do Povo and the neighborhood association Bom Retiro é o Mundo to create a podcast series exploring community narratives and community needs in Bom Retiro, a suburb in Saõ Paulo, Brazil. The podcast was an experimental deep-dive into the multi-layered reality of an inner-city community, drawing on the lived experiences of the residents to show how structural discrimination effects their every day lives.







Impacts



We worked with 8 female or queer-led organizations

Through panels, workshops, and capacity-building workshops we reached 331 participants

Organizations like Yarrow are important because they fill in very important but often left behind gaps that larger, more well-funded, well known, well-staffed cannot hope to fill. Yarrow focusses on the intersectionalities of life because they understand that "one size DOES NOT fit all". 

How do we work?

A view at our finances shows how within our company we redirect funds from areas in which we are profit-oriented to areas in which we see the potential to support transformational change. Our main area of income (economic-based operations) is consulting and analysis for institutions wanting to initiate change at an organizational level in order to have a more positive impact on people and the planet. We then redirect these funds into areas in which we see potential for innovation and collaboration (knowledge and media production and purpose-based operations). These are projects like our blog or our podcast project that contribute to a better understanding of gendered effects of climate change on health and experiment with new ways of thinking about international cooperation.

And finally, our attitude is utopic: we believe a better world is possible.


Our content focuses on intersectional and gender-based-violence, the impact of climate change on gender, and transformative leadership practices. We are continuing to grow and challenge the status quo
